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You are being asked to be in this registry (of hip and pelvis pain comprehensive data documentation) because you are seeking treatment for Hip and/or lower extremity pain by the university of Colorado Hospital department of Orthopaedics hip service.

If you agree to participate in this study you will be asked to release medical information pertaining to your treatment. These records will include the results of any procedures and information about your response to treatment, as well as other medical information related to your care.

The data that will be collected include the following:

- Basic information e.g. non-personal Demographic
- Pertinent medical history
- Information regarding the surgical procedure (such as length of the procedure, estimated blood loss, specific implant device used)
- X-Ray evaluation
- Hip evaluation scoring information (such as pain evaluation and range of motion assessment)
- Serious post-operative effects

This study is designed to learn more about how to treat patients with hip and lower extremity pain.

Possible discomforts or risks include the risk that people outside of the research team will see your research information. We will do all that we can to protect your information, but it cannot be guaranteed. There may be risks the researchers have not thought of.

Every effort will be made to protect your privacy and confidentiality. Steps taken include all identifying information will be stored in a secured place and only the research team will have access.

You have a choice about being in this study. You do not have to be in this study if you do not want to be and have a choice to withdraw at anytime. There will be no change in procedures performed compared to the standard care provided by your physician normally for your condition. The use and disclosure of your information has no time limit.
